STATEMENT OF FAITH

We believe the Bible is the Word of God, (66 books) supernaturally and inherently revealed in its original documents, and is the supreme, final authority in faith and life. (II Tim.3:16)

We believe in One God, eternally existing in three persons, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, co-equal in power and glory, identical in their essential nature, and worthy of precisely the same honor, obedience, and love. (Deut. 6:4,5; Col. 1:15,16; 2:9; Jn. 1:1)

We believe Jesus Christ is God born in human flesh; was virgin-born, having been conceived by the Holy Spirit; is both fully God and fully Man, that He might reveal God and redeem sinful men. (John 1:1, 2, 14; Luke 1:35)

We believe man was created innocent, but through sin he brought spiritual and physical death to himself and all his posterity. (Gen. 1:26, 27; Rom. 5:12)

We believe the sole rescue from this state is by God's grace alone, through faith alone, in the Lord Jesus Christ alone, who died a substitutionary death on the cross for the sins of the world and rose bodily from the dead to offer eternal life to who so ever would believe in Him. (John 3:16; Rom. 3:23; 5:8; 6:23; II Cor. 5:21; Eph. 2:8; 1 Jn 2:2)

We believe all true believers are children of God, and that He has made full provision for their sanctification, victory, and guarantee of eternal life through faith in Jesus Christ and the ministries of the Holy Spirit; who is the Divine Teacher who guides believers into all truth. (John 1:12; 16:13; I John 2:20, 27; Eph. 1:13,14; 5:18)

We believe that all believers are to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace, fervently loving one another with a pure heart. And that believers are re-created in Christ Jesus to be ambassadors of Him and to the world. (Eph. 4:1-6; II Cor. 5:17-21)

We believe that great tribulation and judgment will follow this current age, and that this time of judgment will be consummated with the personal, visible return of Jesus Christ to earth to subdue all His enemies and to set up His kingdom. (Rev. 19:11- 20:4)

We believe that at death the spirits and souls of those who have trusted in the Lord Jesus Christ for salvation pass immediately into His presence in conscious blessedness, and that at Christ's coming for the Church, their bodies will be raised and reunited with their souls to be with Him forever in glory, transformed into His likeness. (II Cor. 5:8; I Cor. 15:51-57; I Thess. 4:16,17)

We believe that all those who do not accept God's gracious offer of salvation in this life remain, after death, in conscious misery until the final judgment of the Great White Throne when soul and body reunited shall be cast into the lake of fire, to endure everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord. (Rev. 20:11-15)

We believe all believers are responsible to walk in separation from all religious apostasy and worldly and sinful practices, witnessing by life and word to the saving power of Christ extended to all men. (Eph. 4:1-3; Acts 1:8)
